


Installation Instructions

PRE-INSTALLATION AND OPERATION

Before beginning the installation, make sure the distance between the final resting place of the faucet and the bathtub is adequate:

- While opening and closing, the handle should not be blocked by the bathtub.
- When open, the water should fall straight down in the bathtub, not on the lip or on the floor.

ASSEMBLE THE FAUCET


1. Attach the supply hoses to the spout. Use plumbers tape to ensure a tight seal and prevent leaks.


IMPORTANT: The hot side inlet tube is indicated by a label. Avoid twisting inlet tubes together.

- 2. Slide the main tube over the supply lines and secure it to the spout.
- 3. Slide the decorative flange cover over the main tube.
- 4. Attach the seat to the main tube.
- 5. Dry fit the faucet and check its position to the tub. Carefully mark the holes where the seat contacts the floor.

INSTALL THE FAUCET

- 1. Using a 10mm drill bit, drill previously marked holes.
- 2. Gently hammer the mounting screws into the holes
- 3. Thread the nut on the supply lines onto the outlet of the water supply valves. Do not overtighten.
- 4. Slide the seat in place, thread the nut onto the screws and tighten with a wrench. Do not overtighten.
- 5. Slide the decorative flange cover over the seat.
- 6. Attach the handshower.

FINISHING

- 1. After installation is completed, turn on the hot and cold water supplies. Check for leaks.
- 2. Pull the hand shower out of the spout and remove the spray head by unscrewing it from the hose in a counterclockwise direction. Be sure to hold the end of the hose down into the tub and turn the tub faucet on to the warm position where it mixes hot and cold water.
- 3. Flush the water lines for one minute. This flushes away any debris that could cause damage to internal parts.
- 4. Check for leaks. Re-tighten any connections if necessary, but do not overtighten.
- 5. Reinstall the handshower by hand tightening it back onto the spray hose.

Care & Maintenance



Our tub fillers are engineered for superior performance inside and out. Following a regular cleaning schedule and understanding how to maintain your fixtures is key to keeping the finishes intact for years to come.

To maintain the luster of your tub filler we recommend wiping your faucet with a damp cloth and mild household cleanser. Dry with a soft cloth.

Remove hard water stains with a 50/50 solution of white vinegar and water. Rinse thoroughly with water afterward.

SUGGESTED MAINTENANCE

- To prevent the accumulation of mineral deposits, dry your fixtures with a soft cloth after each use
- To remove difficult mineral desposits on your handshower, unscrew it from the assembly. Soak it in a 50/50 vinegar and water solution for several hours. Rub stubborn deposits with a soft toothbrush. Rinse thoroughly and dry with a soft cloth.
- Applying carnauba wax to your fixtures is a great way to maintain the finish in the long-term because it helps prevent mineral deposits and other buildup. Whether you have oil rubbed bronze or chrome fixtures, apply wax twice annually to maintain them.

CAUTION

- DO NOT clean your tub filler, supply lines or drains with any type of abrasive cleaner. Although your fixture's finish is extremely durable, it can be damaged or scratched by harsh cleaners or abrasives. Avoid the following:
 - Products that state on the label that they remove tarnish and rust
 - Products containing hydrofluoric, hydrochloric and/or phosphoric acids and caustic agents
 - · Industrial cleaners,
 - Abrasive cleaners

- Toilet bowl cleaners
- Bleach-based cleaners
- Polish
- Ammonia solutions
- Heavy-duty scrub sponges
- DO NOT use drain cleaners, since they could strip the finish from the drain. If you have to, remove the drain pop-up and pour the cleaner carefully so that it touches only the plumbing it's being poured into.
